

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)

Notice of Temporary Traffic Order
Longcot Road, Shrivenham and Ashbury Parishes
Prohibition of Through Traffic
Date of Order: 23 August 2010 -
Coming into force: 6 September 2010

This Order is being introduced because of culvert replacement works in part of Longcot Road, Shrivenham and Ashbury which is anticipated to take 6 weeks to complete.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Longcot Road, southeast of Shrivenham, from a point 1600 metres westwards from its junction with the B4508 for a distance of 1600 metres.

Exemptions are included for police, fire and ambulance services and for the works and for vehicular access to adjacent premises which are only accessible from the closed section of road.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is via Shrivenham, Watchfield and the B4508 & vice versa.

This Order will remain in force for a maximum period of eighteen months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
